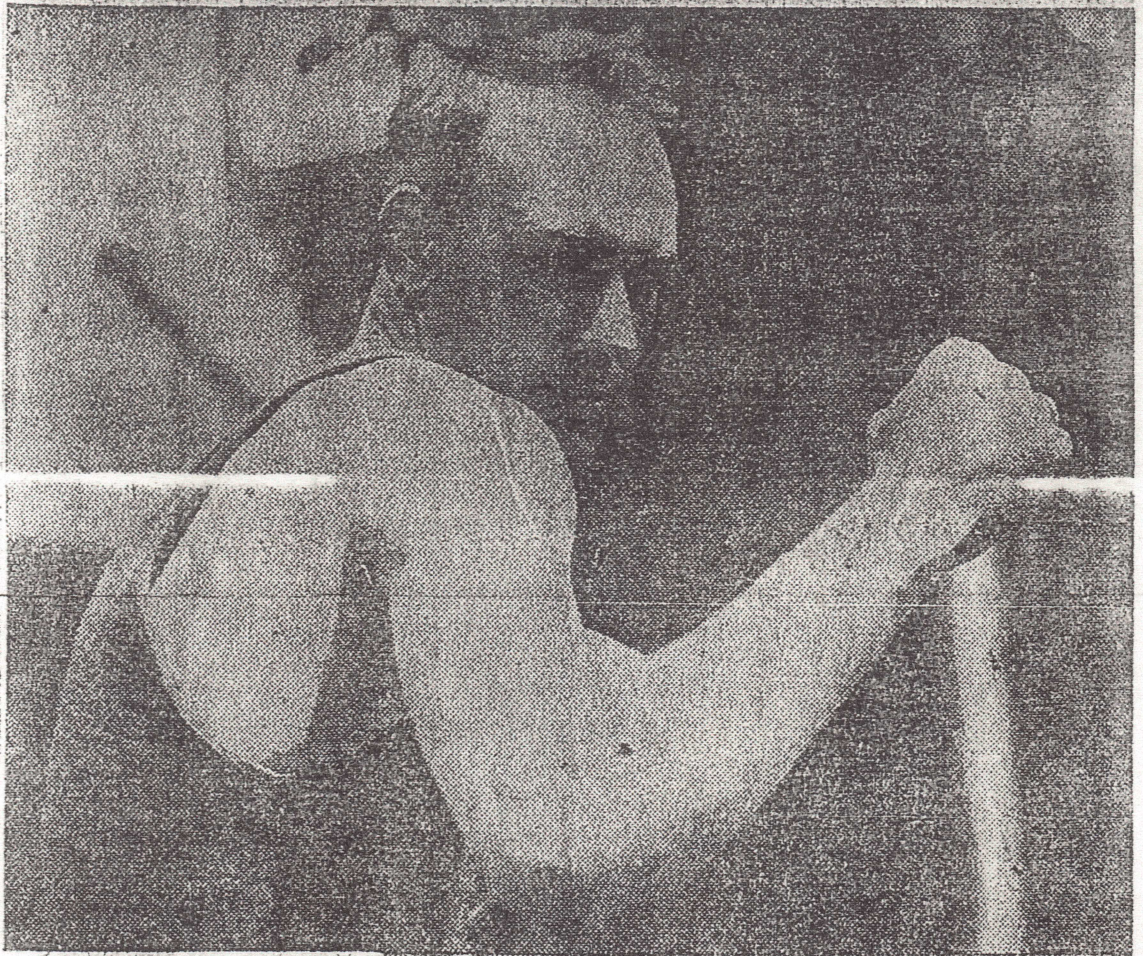


A Mighty Arm—Idle by Mother's Plea
