

## Hohnstein Rites Due Wednesday

REDMOND — Graveside services for Mrs. Emma Hohnstein will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday at Greenwood cemetery in Bend with Rev. D. L. Penhollow in charge.

Mrs. Hohnstein, mother of Mrs. Jack Shumway of Powell Butte and Pete Hohnstein of Alfalfa, died Christmas morning at Providence hospital, Portland, following a cerebral hemorrhage two days earlier. She had made her home in Portland with another daughter, Mrs. Eleanor Christensen. Word of death was received in Central Oregon on Monday.

Mrs. Hohnstein was born in Russia December 18, 1879 and came to the United States with her parents when she was a child. She married John Hohnstein in Denver, Colo. in 1899 and they moved to Portland in 1906. In 1920 they came to Central Oregon farming in the Alfalfa community until her husband's death in 1953. After selling their home place she moved to Portland to live with Mrs. Christensen, spending summers in Central Oregon. Another son, John Hohnstein, lives in Beaverton, and she also leaves 10 grandchildren and witht great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Tuesday morning at Pearson Mortuary in Portland with Rev. Kenneth Biel officiating.
